

## Winchcombe School: Catch-Up Premium 2019-2020

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives state-funded schools, including special schools and alternative provision settings, additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (Y6).

- Funding allocation for the current academic year, 2019-2020 is: £8,895

- ***Spend for 2019-2020:***

**Literacy** – Specific packages, to supporting Year 7 ‘catch-up’, includes:

1. *ARROW* (reading)
2. *Reading Wise*
3. *Twinkl*

**Numeracy** – Specific package, to support Year 7 ‘catch-up’:

1. ‘Maths Catch-Up’ workbook delivered by specialist subject teachers to identified students

**Literacy:**

- 50% of students made ‘expected’ progress; 50% of students made ‘more than expected’ progress
